DAY 1 | ARRIVAL IN HANOI

Upon arrival in Hanoi, you will be met for transportation to your hotel for check-in. The remainder of the day is free at your leisure. Stay two nights at the Silk Path Hotel (or similar).

DAY 2 | HANOI (B)

Enjoy a full day guided tour of the city. Highlights include the Ba Dinh Square area where you'll see the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (photo-stop/outside), his former residence, the Governor's Residence, and then the symbolic One Pillar Pagoda before visiting the Temple of Literature. In the afternoon, stop at the Hoa Lo Prison Museum (aka 'Hanoi Hilton'), the Hoan Kiem Lake area including Ngoc Son Temple, and then discover the winding streets of the Old Quarter by cyclo (pedalled rickshaw). Return to the hotel for the evening free at your leisure.

DAY 3 | HANOI - HALONG BAY (B/L/D)

Depart Hanoi to Halong (approx. 4 hours). Upon your arrival, enjoy a welcome drink and board your sailing junk for your one night cruise of Halong Bay. Admire the scenery, disembark for excursions to view points, caves, and more, and enjoy on board activities and entertainment. Stay one night on board the Bhaya Junk (or similar).

DAY 4 | HALONG BAY - HANOI - HUE (B)

Spend the morning cruising through the limestone cliffs and emerald waters of Halong Bay before disembarkation for transportation to the airport in Hanoi for your flight to Hue in Central Vietnam. Stay two nights in Hue at the Eldora Hotel (or similar).

DAY 5 | HUE (B)

Venture into the countryside to see two Imperial Tombs of past Emperors. Explore the beautifully elaborate Tomb of Khai Dinh, and stroll about the impressive and sprawling tomb of Khai Dinh. In the afternoon, visit the Imperial Citadel in the heart of Hue, a vast complex built in the early 19th century, and later, visit the Thien Mu Pagoda, just outside of Hue, on the banks of the Perfume River and then enjoy a sunset cruise back to your hotel.

DAY 6 | HUE - HOI AN (B)

Drive along the coast and via the Hai Van mountain pass to the town of Hoi An. En route, make a stop at the photogenic village of Lang Co. On arrival in Hoi An, stop at a lantern making workshop and then take guided a walking tour of the old town. Stay two nights in Hoi An at the Silk Marina Resort & Spa (or similar).

DAY 7 | HOI AN (B)

Enjoy the full day at your leisure, or join an optional tour. Please inquire.

DAY 8 | HOI AN - HO CHI MINH CITY (B)

Meet at the hotel for transportation to the airport for your flight to Ho Chi Minh City in South Vietnam. On arrival, meet your guide and depart on your tour of the city. See the Reunification Palace (photo-stop/outside), the Notre Dame Cathedral, and Central Post Office in the center of the city and then head to Cholon, Saigon's Chinatown, for a discovery of this vibrant and culturally rich district before visiting one of the city's key temples or pagodas. Stay two nights in Ho Chi Minh City at the Liberty Central Riverside Hotel (or similar).

DAY 9 | HO CHI MINH CITY & MEKONG DELTA (B/L)

Take a full day excursion to the Mekong Delta. Depart the city in the morning and head to a town on the river. Experience a horse-drawn cart ride to visit a local house where you will enjoy tea and taste home grown fruit. Board a sampan and drift along the narrow, tree-lined canals for further exploration of the Mekong Delta, and after lunch, visit a family-run business making coconut candy before returning to town. On the return trip to Ho Chi Minh City, visit the Vinh Trang Pagoda if time permits. Arrive in the city by late afternoon and have the evening at your leisure.

DAY 10 | HO CHI MINH CITY - SIEM REAP (B)

Visit the amazing Cu Chi Tunnels where Vietnamese guerrillas built a labyrinth of narrow tunnels as hideouts during the war, and then return to Ho Chi Minh City in the afternoon for your flight to Siem Reap in Cambodia, home to the Temples of Angkor. On arrival, meet and transfer to the hotel for some time at your leisure. Stay two nights in Siem Reap at the Tara Angkor Hotel (or similar).

DAY 11 | SIEM REAP (B)

Today you will visit the Angkor archaeological park. See the key temples within Angkor Thom, and more. Highlights include the Bayon Temple, Ta Prohm, and magnificent Angkor Wat. This evening, see a spectacular sunset over the monuments.

DAY 12 | SIEM REAP (B/D)

Visit the graceful 11th century Temple of Shiva, Banteay Srei, with its rarely seen sculpted female deities and then take a boat ride on the Tonle Sap Lake to see the floating villages and rural communities around the lake. Tonight, dinner is included at a local restaurant accompanied by a traditional Khmer Apsara dance performance.

DAY 13 | SIEM REAP – DEPARTURE (B)

Meet at the hotel for transportation to the airport.
