DAY 1 | ARRIVAL IN HANOI

Upon arrival in Hanoi, you will be met for transportation to your hotel for check-in. The remainder of the day is free at your leisure. Stay two nights at the Silk Path Hotel (or similar).

DAY 2 | HANOI (B)

Enjoy a full day tour of Hanoi with your English speaking guide. Walk through Ba Dinh Square, see the imposing Ho Chi Minh mausoleum before moving onto his wooden stilt house and the One Pillar Pagoda. You will then explore the first university of Vietnam, the Temple of Literature, which is imbued with the profound philosophies of Confucianism. In the afternoon, experience a culinary and immersive experience as you explore local markets, bustling streets and tempt your palate with stops at food stalls for insight into regional treats. Afterwards, take a pedalled-rickshaw (cyclo) ride around the maze of streets in the Old Quarter. Return to your hotel for the evening at your leisure.



DAY 3 | HANOI - HALONG BAY (B/L/D)

Depart Hanoi to Halong (approx. 4 hours). Upon your arrival, enjoy a welcome drink and board your sailing junk for your one night cruise of Halong Bay. Admire the scenery, disembark for excursions to view points, caves, and more, and enjoy on board activities and entertainment. Stay one night on board the Bhaya Junk (or similar).

DAY 4 | HALONG BAY - HANOI - HUE (B)

Enjoy the morning cruising through the limestone scenery and emerald waters of the Bay before returning to the wharf area to meet your transportation back to Hanoi and to the airport for your flight to Hue in Central Vietnam. Stay two nights in Hue at the Saigon Morin Hotel (or similar).

DAY 5 | HUE (B/L)

Venture into the countryside to the Imperial Tomb of Khai Dinh, a beautifully elaborate tomb mixing Vietnamese & European styles located on a hillside, and then experience the warmth and hospitality of the Vietnamese on an excursion to gain further insight into the culture and daily life of the locals in Hue. Traditional customs, the way of life, cooking traditions, and Hue's specialties are just some of the things you will experience. Enjoy a nice local lunch with your host's family. In the afternoon, visit the Imperial Citadel in the heart of Hue, a vast complex built in the early 19th century, and later, visit the Thien Mu Pagoda, just outside of Hue, on the banks of the Perfume River and then enjoy a sunset cruise back to your hotel.

DAY 6 | HUE - HOI AN (B)

Drive along the coast and via the Hai Van mountain pass to the town of Hoi An. En route, make a stop at the photogenic village of Lang Co. On arrival in Hoi An, stop at a lantern making workshop and then take guided a walking tour of the old town. Stay two nights in Hoi An at the Royal Riverside Hotel (or similar).

DAY 7 | HOI AN (B)

Enjoy the full day at your leisure, or join an optional tour. Please inquire.

DAY 8 | HOI AN - HO CHI MINH CITY (B)

Meet at the hotel for transportation to the airport for your flight to Ho Chi Minh City in South Vietnam. On arrival, meet and transfer to the hotel for the rest of the day at your leisure. Optional night tour is available. Please inquire. Stay three nights in Ho Chi Minh City at the Renaissance Riverside Hotel (or similar).

DAY 9 | HO CHI MINH CITY (B/L)

Visit the amazing Cu Chi Tunnels where Vietnamese guerrillas built a labyrinth of narrow tunnels as hideouts during the war, and then return to Ho Chi Minh City in the afternoon for a half-day tour of the city. Highlights include the Reunification Palace (photo stop), the Notre Dame Cathedral, the Central Post Office, the War Remnants Museum, and Cho'lon, the city's bustling Chinatown.

DAY 10 | HO CHI MINH CITY & MEKONG DELTA (B/L)

Take a full day excursion to the Mekong Delta. Depart the city in the morning and head to a town on the river. Experience a horse-drawn cart ride to visit a local house where you will enjoy tea and taste home grown fruit. Board a sampan and drift along the narrow, tree-lined canals for further exploration of the Mekong Delta, and after lunch, visit a family-run business before returning to town. On the return trip to Ho Chi Minh City, visit the Vinh Trang Pagoda if time permits. Arrive in the city by late afternoon and have the evening at your leisure.

DAY 11 | HO CHI MINH CITY - SIEM REAP (B/D)

Fly to Siem Reap in Cambodia, home to the Temples of Angkor. On arrival, meet and transfer to the hotel for some time at your leisure. This evening, enjoy dinner with a traditional Apsara performance at a local restaurant.

DAY 12 | SIEM REAP (B)

Today you will visit the Angkor archaeological park. See the key temples within Angkor Thom, and more. Highlights include the Bayon Temple, Ta Prohm, and magnificent Angkor Wat. This evening, see a spectacular sunset over the monuments.



DAY 13 | SIEM REAP (B)

Visit the graceful 11th century Temple of Shiva, Banteay Srei, with its rarely seen sculpted female deities and then take a boat ride on the Tonle Sap Lake to see the floating villages and rural communities around the lake.

DAY 14 | SIEM REAP - DEPARTURE (B)

Meet at the hotel for transportation to the airport.
